The Citizens Association of Georgetown (CAG) is seeking artists to participate in a show of artwork at the former location of Smith and Hawken (1209 31<sup>st</sup> Street, NW) from November 19-21, 2009.

- The show is open to artists who either **are current residents of Georgetown** or who feature **images of Georgetown** in their work.
- The show will run from Thursday, November 19 to Saturday, November 21 and will feature a reception and guest speaker on Thursday evening and inclusion in the Georgetown Gallery Gaze on Friday evening. Show hours are:

Thursday, 11/19	6 – 9 pm
Friday 11/20	12 – 8 pm
Saturday 11/21	11 am – 6 pm

- Work may be for sale or for display only, as the artist wishes. **All sales of work must be completed directly between the artist and the buyer.** CAG takes no commission on sales. Therefore, artists wishing to sell their work are encouraged to be present for as much of the show as possible. If you are not able to attend, artists should provide contact details for prospective buyers. Sold work should be left up for the duration of the show.
- The show is open to artists working in the following media: painting, photography, sculpture, 2D and 3D mixed media. We cannot accept jewelry or anything requiring electricity. Pieces accepted into the show should be of a suitable nature to be viewed by families with children.
- Artists may submit up to six pieces for inclusion in the show. The final number displayed will depend on space available. (Maximum size per piece is 60" in the largest dimension.) All 2D work must be properly framed and wired for hanging.
- Work must be delivered to Smith & Hawken on Wednesday, November 18 between 4 – 7 pm and picked up on Sunday, November 22 between 12 – 3 pm.
- We need help! Each artist participating in the show must volunteer for two hours. Duties may include assisting with receiving art on 11/18, setting up and/or hosting on 11/19, gallery-sitting on 11/20 -21, or breaking down the show on 11/22.
