please help this tree!

- **Water** slowly and deeply with 20-25 gallons of water each week. This is very important during hot, dry weather.
- **Continue watering as needed**, until the leaves fall off.
- **Resume watering** when new leaves appear in the spring.
- **Do not overwater.** Pull back mulch, test soil with your finger. If soil is wet, do not water.
- **Do not overmulch.** 2-4 inches of mulch is ideal. **Do not let mulch touch the trunk.**
- **Please, no plantings in the tree box** for the first two years; none for three years is even better.
